

# Destroy IT

## PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

**Destroy IT is a water based fungicidal wash solution containing 2% Di-Methyl Benzalkonium Chloride and 0.5% 2-phenoxide, formulated for the treatment of algae and fungal growth on building surfaces.**

**TYPICAL USES** *Destroy IT* is primarily used to help eliminate fungal or organic growth from roofs, walls, ceilings and masonry when preparing surfaces to receive repair materials, paint and other coatings.

**SUITABLE SUBSTRATES** *Destroy IT* may be applied to most common building materials including concrete, brick, block, render, stone, slate, marble, ceramic and quarry tile, grout, mortar, timber and asbestos.

**COLOUR** *Destroy IT* is a colourless clear liquid.

**PACKAGING** *Destroy IT* is supplied in 5.0 litre units and 25.0 litre drums.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

### SURFACE PREPARATION

Moss and similar heavy growth and vegetable matter should be cleared from the surface using a stiff bristle brush or wire brush if necessary. Pressure washing may also help. Ensure the surface is as clean as possible, sound, free of loose or flaking material and dry or damp (but free of standing water) before applying *Destroy IT*.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE *Cont.***

**APPLICATION**

*Shake well before use.*

Apply the solution by brush or broom to the affected area.

After 24 hours, remove any stubborn residues of organic growth by brush or scraper and re-coat any persistent stains.

After application, *Destroy IT* should be left for 24 hours before any further preparation or painting to avoid spreading active spores to the surrounding area.

**APPLICATION TEMPERATURE**

Application temperature should be above +5°C and drying time is approximately 24 hours.

**COVERAGE**

The coverage of *Destroy IT* is up to 50m<sup>2</sup> per 5.0 litre unit, or up to 250m<sup>2</sup> per 25 litre drum, depending on the condition and porosity of the substrate.

**CLEANING**

Tools and equipment should be cleaned using warm soapy water. Hands and skin should be cleaned immediately with Organic Hand Cleaner.

**SHELF LIFE & STORAGE**

Shelf life is up to 12 months, subject to conditions of storage. Store at a temperature between +5°C and +30°C. Protect from frost.
